CLUB INFORMATION

SSYC 2021 ANNUAL MEETING will be held **August 7, 2021, 10:00 am**. All Owners are invited to attend.

SSYC ANNUAL PICNIC will be held **August 7, 12:00pm-5:00pm**, immediately after the Annual Meeting. Hot Dogs and Burgers will be provided. Please bring a dish to pass and your own drinks.

WATERWAY DEPTH. With fluctuating water levels, the entrance from the river is increasingly hazardous. Buoys marking the entrance will be placed shortly.

RIP-RAP REPAIR. Due to the higher water levels we have encountered over the last couple of years, we have been unable to do any rip-rap repairs. It is our intend to do as much as possible this year. (\$65,000 has been allotted).

Our plan is to complete the entire West side from **slip 17 to slip 86** (except a couple of small areas that have already been completed).

In order to accomplish this, all dock boxes, platforms and anything attached to the docks (water hoses, electrical, etc.) must be removed by the Shareholder by **October 1, 2021**.

If you plan to have your boat in an affected slip after this date, arrangements will have to be made with the Fleet Captain for an alternative slip.

After we receive a quote from our contractors, we will be able to advise you of the exact slips that will be affected.

We understand that this is inconvenient to all of us, but it has to be done. Please do your part.

CLUB RULES/GUIDELINES

DOCK HEIGHT. Members can adjust their own dock per club recommendations or Board volunteers will adjust your dock for \$100 per side. Remember to discuss this with your dock mate.

Adjusting the dock height requires use of special equipment available from the club and can be dangerous to those unfamiliar with the process. If you are not familiar with the process, you should discuss the dock adjustment process with a board member or other knowledgeable person before adjusting the dock height. Those electing to adjust dock height assume all risks and liability associated with that process.

COVID RULES – We will continue to follow State Guidelines

EXTRA KEYS/OLD KEYS. Contact Dennis Reinke or Bill Roberts for extra keys. (\$10 each). Please drop old keys in boxes in bath houses.

VOLUNTEERS (MPC). Please help maintain the Club and keep costs down by volunteering for projects.

CHILD SAFETY. Life jackets must be worn by all unsupervised children twelve (12) years old or younger when on club property.

ANTI-SIPHONING DEVICES-Do not remove from hoses, required by law.

DOCK MODIFICATIONS must meet Club standards. Owners, please inform your renters of this requirement.

NO FISH GUTS IN THE DUMPSTERS

PETS ON LEASH. All dogs must be kept on a leash, Pick up after your pet. No pets allowed in the club buildings.

PERSONAL STORAGE. Storage of personal items, including gas cans, are not allowed in any club buildings. Gas cans on club property cannot exceed six (6) gallons.-
