GREETING FROM THE COMMODORE Bill Roberts

Hi All.

I hope everyone enjoyed their time on the water and in port at SSYC this past year.

At our Board Meeting on September 13, 2022 the 2023 assessment was set at \$700. The increase from the last few years is due to our replacing the remainder of the rip-rap and our anticipation of the dredging necessary for next year. Currently we do have the assets required to pay for these two major projects but our reserve will be greatly diminished in 2023. More information on these two projects is described in greater detail below.

Please remember the annual assessment is due May 15th each year without penalty. After July 15 a \$50 per month late fee is assessed. If all fees have not been paid by November 1 a \$500 additional late fee is assessed. Please look for the assessment invoices in mid-March. Timely payment for your slip helps keep the Club running smoothly.

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2022-2023 RIP-RAP REPAIR AND DREDGING INFORMATION

2022 RIP-RAP REPAIR:

Our permit for the repair runs out in February 2023 and we wanted to complete the work before it runs out. Renewals on permits have become a time intensive endeavor.

The scope of the work includes 615ft of repair in the area of slips 109-120, 154-160, 164-173, 181-186 at a base cost of \$45,000. The contractor plans to be on site October 15 with the work completed in about six weeks.

All dock boxes and anything attached to the dock ramp section must be removed by October 15. Dock box supports can be removed by the contractor. Reinstalling the dock box in the spring will need to follow the new standard with steel supports, The supports can be purchased from SSYC at cost.

If your boat will be in one of these slip after October 15, your boat will need to be moved to another slip. Please contact Dennis, Fleet Captain 989-928-4267 to coordinate.

2023 DREDGING

Due to the lower water levels, the entrance waterway was a challenge for many boaters this year. The timeline to receive a permit and hire a dredging contractor requires months to complete. We work with BCYC each year to coordinate permitting and dredging.

We are currently working to hire a dredging contractor to deepen the north entrance of the yacht club to a depth of 6.5ft. The cost is estimated to be about \$116,000 of which we would pay \$45,000.

The dredging spoils are put in a berm at BCYC and stored for a time to allow the dirt to settle and water to evaporate. Recently the two yacht clubs split the cost of hauling and disposing away the sediment from previous dredging at a of cost of \$24,300.

Please be patient in the spring as the boating season gets underway while we also are working on the dredging project.


